

Scholarship Policy

Requests for scholarships are accepted for any family that wants to participate in Stagecraft Theatre for Kids' classes, workshops, and/or camps but is experiencing financial difficulties. Scholarships awarded may be applied towards tuition for our programming. Scholarships are not awarded to cover the costs of production related fees or production items such as t-shirts, makeup kits, and costume items.

Scholarships can assist the recipient family in paying for registration tuition up to 75% of the tuition cost. Exceptions to this rule will be considered on a case by case basis and must be approved by the Board of Directors, leading to potentially covering 100% of the tuition cost.

Families can complete the Tuition Scholarship Application form on the second page below. Forms must be submitted at least week prior to the first day of the program. Late scholarship applications cannot be accepted. Applicants must be willing to submit financial information to be considered for a scholarship award.

All scholarship information is confidentially maintained and is not disclosed or discussed with any other personnel outside of the Artistic Director and Board of Directors. Submitted applications will be confidentially forwarded to the Artistic Director upon submission. The application will be evaluated and processed for immediate consideration. Once an approval response has been received, the applicants will be notified via email from the Artistic Director.

During the time it takes to process the application, applicants must proceed with remitting the 50% tuition payment for registration, prior to the first day of classes. We strive to make the scholarship decisions in a timely manner; however, some time may pass from when the application is submitted and when an approval decision is reached.

Account balances will not be carried over from one session to another. If account balances have not been paid in full by the end of the current session, then the student is ineligible to enroll in subsequent sessions until such time that all account balances have been settled. Scholarship awards are nontransferable.
